## HB 19U Goaltender to Represent Team USA for the Second Time

*Shaw to play in the IIHF Under-18 Women's World Championship*



**Farmington Hills, MI . . . Alexis Shaw**, from the 19U Honeybaked Girls hockey team, has been selected to compete with USA Hockey's Under-18 team in the International Ice Hockey Federation Under-18 Women's World Championship. Games will be played in Heinola and Vierumäki, Finland, from Dec. 29, 2012 to Jan. 5, 2013.

This will be Shaw's second appearance as a member of Team USA this year, as she also competed in a three-game series 2012 Under-18 Series vs. Canada in August in Blaine, Minnesota. The 2013 IIHF U18 Women's World Championship, which was first held in 2008, will be contested for the sixth time. Lexi is the only player from the state of Michigan to be selected to this squad.

Lexi Shaw of Troy, MI is one of two goalies selected to the squad. Shaw is in her senior year at Farmington Hills Mercy High School and has committed to the University of North Dakota for the fall of 2013. This is Lexi's 3rd year with the Honeybaked program and she helped backstop the HB 16U team to the 2011 National Championship.
